


# **Diversity Survey Results 2019**


We are publishing these summary results to ensure that no individuals can be identified. The survey and results will be updated annually.



## Age Distribution




#### Gender



Which gender do you identify with?


Do you consider your gender identity to be different from your registered sex at birth?




## Disability

Are your day-to-day activities limited because of a health problem or disability which has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?










#### **Sexual Orientation**





What is the highest level of qualifications achieved by either of your parent(s) or guardian(s) by the time you were 18?






